Accumulated Homework/Classwork

Homework in US History is an **accumulated Quiz Graded** requirement. You receive a 100% grade for having your homework completed and in class with you when we check and review it. Homework is not graded for accuracy, but rather that you did your best to complete it fully and conscientiously. A 50% grade is given if work has major incompletions or if you hand in your assignment late. A 0% is given for work that is never completed or shown to teacher. Students who are absent do not receive a 0%, but are given time to make up work and if they fail to show it, their number of points per assignment increases because of fewer assignments being graded. It is to the advantage of a student who is absent to complete the work given to them and to hand it in for full credit in a timely manner after returning to school. The number of assignments is averaged and a quiz grade is taken after a significant number of assignments are completed, generally ten or more. **These accumulated quiz grades are never dropped!** They indicate your daily commitment to your work, and sense of responsibility. This policy is the same for both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade US History and for each and every quarter. **This policy is restated frequently and all students are aware of this policy.**
